## Abstract Submission Guidelines

The following Criteria apply  
to ALL Abstracts submitted:

- 1 Submit abstracts at [www.cpcc.ie](http://www.cpcc.ie)
- 2 The abstract text cannot exceed **300 words**
- 3 **15 Word Limit** on the Length of the Abstract Title
- 4 Abstracts must be written in **English**
- 5 Acronyms and abbreviations must be explained
- 6 The abstract text **must not** contain information about the presenters/ institutions involved or identifiable patient information. This is to protect patient anonymity and to facilitate the blind review process.
- 7 Graphs are not allowed in the abstract
- 8 Generic drug names are preferred. The use of trade names should only be used when absolutely necessary
- 9 The author will be asked and is required to indicate the source of funding (if applicable) in the submission process
- 10 The author is required to indicate if their abstract has been presented elsewhere
- 11 Any abstract must have **FULL** results to be considered for
